



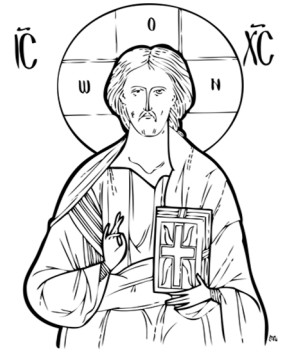

The Transfiguration of Our Lord Jesus Christ



Troparion of the Transfiguration (Tone 7): When, O Christ our God, thou wast transfigured on the mountains, thou didst reveal thy glory to thy Disciples in proportion as they could bear it. Let thine everlasting light also enlighten us sinners, through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O thou Bestower or light, glory to thee.

Kontakion of the Transfiguration (Tone 7): Thou wast transfigured on the mount, and thy Disciples, in so far as they were able, beheld thy glory, O Christ our God, so that, when they should see thee crucified, they would remember that all thy suffering was voluntary, and could declare to all the world that thou art truly the effulgent Splendor of the Father.
