Martyrs Leontios, Hypatios & Theodoulos at Tripoli in Phoenicia; Venerable Leonitios the Hagiorite of Dionysiou Monastery on Athos

Troparion of Resurrection (Tone 1): While the stone was sealed by the Jews, and the soldiers were guarding thy most pure body, thou didst arise on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. For which cause the heavenly powers cried aloud unto thee, O giver of life. Glory to thy Resurrection, O Christ, glory to thy kingdom, glory to thy providence, O thou who alone art the lover of mankind.

Troparion of Sts. Peter & Paul (Tone 4): O first enthroned of the Apostles, teachers of the universe, entreat the Master of all to grant peace to the world and great mercy to our souls.

Kontakion for Ordinary Sundays (Tone 2): O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, mediation unto the Creator most constant, O despise not the suppliant voices of those who have sinned; but be thou quick, O good one, to come unto our aid, who in faith cry unto thee. Hasten to intercession, and speed thou to make supplication, thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.
